

What is the BFA Program


- Started in 1996 low bar

- Program recognizes communities for bicycle friendliness and provides roadmap and assistance to become better.

- 291 BFCs in 48 states
- Four Platinum BFCs Boulder, CO; Davis, CA; Fort Collins, CO & Portland, OR
- Four BFCs in TX-Austin (Silver) Houston, San Antonio, The Woodlands(Bronze)

- Started in 2008
- 541 BFBs in 46 states

16 BFBs in Texas















GROWTH IN BIKE COMMUTING 2000-2012




