## 13A. FUTURE AMENDMENTS TO THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

## BACKGROUND

The 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a four-year capital improvements program for transportation projects. Under federal rules, all federally assisted projects must be included in the TIP to be eligible for funding. In addition, federal rules require that regionally significant local projects must also be included in the TIP.

The 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is a long-range plan that prioritizes spending on regional transportation projects including short and long-range strategies to ensure the transportation network is safe and efficient. Updated every four years, the RTP outlines a fiscally constrained transportation investment program that is based on the unique needs and characteristics of the MPO region.

Amendments to the TIP and RTP are brought to the Transportation Policy Council for consideration monthly and amended in accordance with the H-GAC Public Participation Plan.

## CURRENT SITUATION

A summary of the proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 TIP and 2045 RTP are included below for the Committee's review.

- Advance METRO's METRORapid Gulfton Corridor southern extension (formerly 'Uptown Bus Rapid southern extension') project (MPO ID 18160) from FY 2028 in the Ten-Year Plan (10Y) into FY 2024 of the TIP, increasing local funding from \$169.3M to \$250.0M, to align it with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Small Starts program application for federal funding. (+\$80.7M; Total Cost: \$250.0M)
- Advance the Regional Transit Fare Collection System (FY 2023-2026) set-aside project (MPO ID 18260) from FY 2025 in the 10Y into FY 2023 of the TIP, increasing federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) funding from \$12.7M to \$40.3M, which would be matched with 8M Transportation Development Credits (TDCs), to fully fund the system for implementation. Also, change the sponsor from the Houston-Galveston Area Council to METRO and designate the authorized phase as 'Transfer' to enable the funds to be transferred to the FTA. (+\$27.7M; Total Cost: \$40.3M)
- Add \$688K total (\$344K Federal and \$344K Local Match) of Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funding to the Memorial City Redevelopment Authority's FY 2019 Gessner Road Reconstruction project (MPOID 17129) to cover unforeseen increases in construction management and engineering caused by changes in contract regulations. (+\$688K; Total Cost: \$15.0M)
- Increase Right-of-Way (ROW) funding on TxDOT Houston District's IH 10 West reconstruction and widening project (MPOID 10334) to cover increased estimates for utilities relocation. (+\$19.0M; Total Cost: \$152.7M)

- Delay TxDOT Houston District's SH 35/SP 5 freeway construction project (MPOID 209) to FY 2026 due to ROW issues and to coordinate it with an adjacent City of Houston project. Also, make a minor clarification in the description. (Total Cost: \$60.6M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's SH 35 frontage roads construction project (MPOID 210) to FY 2026 due to ROW issues. Also, make a minor clarification in the description. (Total Cost: \$20.2M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's IH 610 direct connectors construction at SH 35 project (MPOID 18048) to FY 2026 due to ROW and utilities issues and to coordinate it with an adjacent City of Houston project. Also, make a minor clarification in the description. (Total Cost: \$200.7M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's FM 517 widening project (MPOID 38) to FY 2028 due to ROW issues. (Total Cost: \$87.8M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's SH 36 widening project (MPOID 263) to FY 2026 due to ROW and utilities issues. (Total Cost: \$45.0M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's FM 2100 reconstruction and widening project (MPOID 290) to FY 2026 due to ROW issues. (Total Cost: \$42.9M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's FM 2920 Intelligent Transportation System installation project (MPOID 17045) to FY 2027 due to a pending City of Tomball decision regarding design and ROW issues for the corridor's access management project. (Total Cost: \$1.9M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's FM 1960 Intelligent Transportation System installation project (MPOID 17088) to FY 2026 to coordinate scheduling with intersection improvements on the corridor. (Total Cost: \$10.9M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's FM 518 shared-use path construction project (MPOID 17122) to FY 2024 due to utilities issues. (Total Cost: \$13.4M)
- Delay TxDOT Houston District's US 90A reconstruction and widening project (MPOID 18029) to FY 2025 due to utilities issues. (Total Cost: \$35.0M)

The Memorial City Redevelopment Authority (MCRA) was awarded funding by the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) for the subject project in 2015. The project design was completed in May 2019, construction began in July 2019 and construction was completed in November 2021. In January 2023 we received initial project close-out documentation from the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT). The close out documentation indicated that the project had experienced \$829,529.50 in increased costs between project letting and project close-out. Most of this cost increase (\$687,931.84) is associated with the costs that TxDOT incurred via their performance of construction management services for the project. The notification received in January 2023 was the first time that cost information associated with construction management services had been relayed to the MCRA.

Upon project letting, TxDOT provided an estimate for their construction management and engineering reviews of 1,290,000 (9% of total cost). At close out, those costs totaled 1,977,931.84 (13.4% of construction cost). The project was let and managed by TxDOT. Construction management services were provided by TxDOT, via a third-party contractor. The MCRA was not party to the award or management of that contract.

The project was completed per the project schedule and the construction contract itself was generally consistent with the budget and engineer's estimate (within 1.4%). TxDOT informed the MCRA that the reason for the increased construction management and engineering cost was due to the utilization of a third-party contractor rather than TxDOT staff, which is a change in how TxDOT has managed local government projects in the past. This method of completing the work was not incorporated in TxDOT's original statement of cost received by the MCRA in 2019.

The MCRA requests H-GAC participation in the amount associated with TxDOT's increased construction management and engineering costs of \$687,931.84. The MCRA interprets this as different than a cost increase; it is a cost generated due to an unforeseeable change in regulations being applied to this project. It is our understanding that a similar shift to third-party construction management has been applied to another MCRA project that is underway, indicating that this is a condition that may affect other projects in the region.

I am writing to request your assistance in the development of the METRORapid Gulfton Corridor project that introduces Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) service into the Gulfton area. This project is a part of METRONext and is included in the air quality conforming 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) as:

MPOID /Facility Name:18160/Uptown BRTLimits:Bellaire/Uptown Transit Center to Gulfton Transit<br/>Center (5.2 miles)Description:Southern extension of Uptown BRTCost:\$169.34 million

It is METRO's intention to submit the project to the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) later this year for consideration for Small Starts grant funding. To ensure compliance with the Small Starts application requirements and to ensure the project is competitive for the federal fiscal year 2025 budget cycle, METRO requests your assistance in advancing the project into the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and Statewide TIP (STIP) for the May 2023 Quarterly Revision.

METRO requests an amendment to the 2023-2026 TIP to move the project from the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan's (RTP) 10-year plan to fiscal year 2024 in the TIP. To align the TIP/STIP with the Small Starts application, the project information should be updated as follows:

MPOID /Facility Name: Limits: 18160/METRORapid Gulfton Corridor

Westpark/Lower Uptown Transit Center to vicinity of Hillcroft Avenue and Beechnut Street (approximately 5 miles)

Description: Cost: Southern extension of METRORapid Silver Line \$250 million

The METRORapid Gulfton Corridor project should be shown as locally funded pending a federal award. Design is anticipated to begin in fiscal year 2024 with construction beginning in fiscal year 2025. METRO will seek federal funding assistance for all project phases including environmental, right-of-way, utilities, design, and construction.

The current design concept represents a modest realignment of the concept shown in METRONext and is based on ongoing public engagement and discussion with stakeholders along the corridor. The route will begin at the Westpark/Lower Uptown Transit Center and will end on-street in the vicinity of Hillcroft Avenue and Beechnut Street. The approximate length and scope of the project are unchanged. The slight realignment should not pose any risk to the conformity determination, especially when considering that modeled emissions for the 2045 RTP are much lower than the State Implementation Plan budgets for the region. It is anticipated that the realignment will result in higher ridership along the route, resulting in a larger shift from single auto occupancy to transit during peak periods.

## **RE: TIP Project Revisions - Regional Fare Collection System**

Dear Mr. Raborn:

On behalf of the Regional Fare Collection System project partners within the Houston-Galveston region, this letter and attached forms request the revision of the project (MPOID 18620) to the FY 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) as well as the application of Transportation Development Credits (TDCs).

In 2018, The Transportation Policy Council (TPC) reserved \$20 Million to implement this high priority project and METRO has subsequently made significant progress. This proposed amendment would fully utilize both the initial funding of \$20 Million and requests an additional \$20.3 Million to support the increased costs of hardware, software and other project elements. As shown in the attached cost estimates, the additional \$20.3 Million will ultimately be required to fully fund the project to completion and demonstration.
