

11. AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION STATEWIDE SAFETY PROGRAM, THE 2025-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

BACKGROUND

The 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a four-year capital improvements program for transportation projects. Under federal rules, all federally assisted projects must be included in the TIP to be eligible for funding. In addition, federal rules require that regionally significant local projects must also be included in the TIP.

The 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is a long-range plan that prioritizes spending on regional transportation projects including short and long-range strategies to ensure the transportation network is safe and efficient. Updated every four years, the RTP outlines a fiscally constrained transportation investment program that is based on the unique needs and characteristics of the MPO region.

Amendments to the TIP and RTP are brought to the Transportation Policy Council for consideration monthly and amended in accordance with the H-GAC Public Participation Plan.

CURRENT SITUATION

A summary of the proposed revisions to the Texas Department of Transportation Statewide Safety Program is included below for the Council's review.

- Add \$1.8M of federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funding to the Houston-Galveston Area Council's Regional Freeway Incident Management project (MPO ID 11917) to fund continuing towing operations. An additional 352K Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) will be programmed in lieu of matching funds.
- Add \$3.1M of federal STBG funding to the Houston-Galveston Area Council's Regional Freeway Incident Management project (MPO ID 17020) to fund continuing towing operations. An additional 616K TDCs will be programmed in lieu of matching funds.

A summary of the proposed revisions to the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program is included below.

- Program fourteen (14) Gulf Coast Transit District Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Urban Area Formula (Section 5307) funded preventative maintenance and operations projects in FY 2025 with FY 2021-2024 apportionments with 5.7M TDCs in lieu of matching funds.
- Program ten (10) Gulf Coast Transit District FTA Bus and Bus Facility Program (Section 5339) funded bus replacement and maintenance, and bus and facility camera purchases in FY 2025 with FY 2021-2024 apportionments with 325K TDCs in lieu of matching funds.
- Program four (4) Woodlands Township FTA Bus and Bus Facility Program (Section 5339) funded bus and trolley acquisition purchases in FY 2025 with FY 2019-2025 apportionments with 280K TDCs in lieu of matching funds.

- Program three (3) METRO FTA Section 5307 State-of-Good-Repair, Metrolift ADA support and safety & security projects in FY 2025 with FY 2023 apportionments.
- Program one (1) METRO FTA Section 5337 State of Good Repair Fixed Guideway project in FY 2025 with a FY 2023 apportionment.
- Revise the funding of six (6) Woodlands Township FTA Section 5307 funded capital, planning and operating projects in FY 2025 with FY 2020 and 2021 apportionments in anticipation of the approval of 1.5M TDCs to be used in lieu of matching funds.
- Revise the funding and matching TDCs of one (1) Woodlands Township FTA Section 5339 funded bus acquisition and facilities project in FY 2025 with a FY 2023 apportionment based on the actual allocation.
- Revise the funding and matching TDCs of two (2) Harris County Transit FTA Section 5307 funded planning and operating projects in FY 2025 with a FY 2022 apportionments based on the actual allocations.
- Advance METRO's FTA Section 5339 bus replacement and fueling facility project from FY 2026 to FY 2025 at METRO's request.

AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS OF THE 2025-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA.

WHEREAS, the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on May 19, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program for the Houston-Galveston Metropolitan Planning Area was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on June 28, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revisions to the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan and its finding of conformance with the State Implementation Plan for air quality; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revisions to the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the federal fiscal constraint requirements established for the Transportation Improvement Program and are consistent with the financially constrained 2045 Regional Transportation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA THAT THE 2025–2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN BE AMENDED TO REFLECT THE REVISIONS IDENTIFIED IN THE TABLE OF **SEPTEMBER 2024 TPC AMENDMENTS**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT FEDERAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC FROM THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG) PROGRAMS REPRESENT A LIMITING AMOUNT. ANY COST OVERRUNS ON PHASES OF WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC OR COSTS INCURRED ON PHASES OF WORK NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROJECT SPONSOR. IN NO CASE, SHALL FEDERAL PARTICIPATION UNDER THE CMAQ AND STBG PROGRAMS BE INCREASED WITHOUT CONSULTATION AND THE EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE TPC.

APPROVING THE AWARD OF TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS (TDCs) AND AUTHORIZING RELATED AMENDMENTS TO THE 2025-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP), AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA.

WHEREAS, Texas Administrative Code, Title 43 Subchapter H, identifies the purpose, goals, and administrative requirements for the Transportation Development Credit Program in the State of Texas, including the sub-allocation of credits to Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs); and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has documented the current balance of credits allocated to H-GAC, the MPO for the Houston-Galveston Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, Texas Administrative Code, Title 43 §5.106, establishes requirements for the award of Transportation Development Credits by MPOs; and

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council has established a documented process for the evaluation of applications and the award of credits; and

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council is in receipt of requests for credits; and

WHEREAS, the award of credits for these purposes is consistent with the Policy governing the consideration of requests for credits adopted by the Policy Council on November 20, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON METROPOLITAN PLANNING AREA THAT TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PROJECTS IN THE ATTACHED TABLE#1 AND THAT THE TRANSPORTATION DIRECTOR IS DIRECTED TO ENTER INTO ANY NECESSARY PROJECT AGREEMENTS.

Provided below is a revised list showing the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 funding allocations for the individual Section 5307 transit operators in Texas from the Governor's Apportionment.

The attached FY 2023 split letter dated May 3, 2023 was comprised of the full FY 2023 apportionment of \$57,715,169 and an additional amount of 2,944,216 of funds released from McKinney and awarded pro-rata to all agencies for a total amount of \$60,659,385 distributed in the split letter. McKinney then inadvertently applied for and were awarded the \$2,944,216 of FY 2018 funds in TrAMS.
