



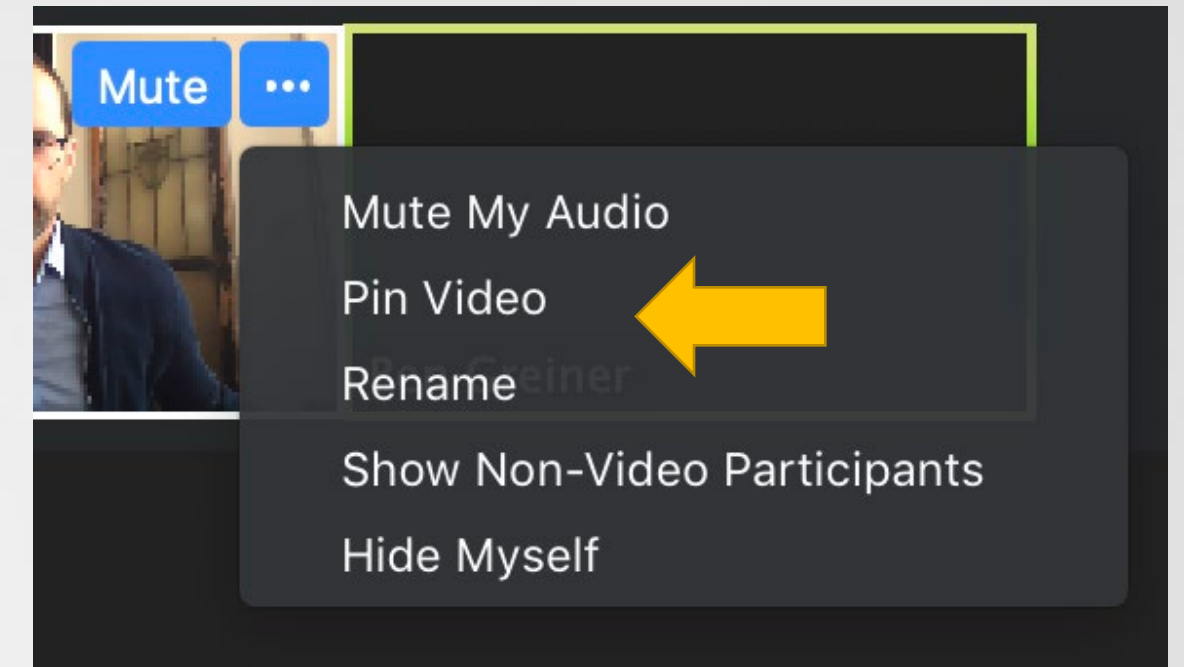

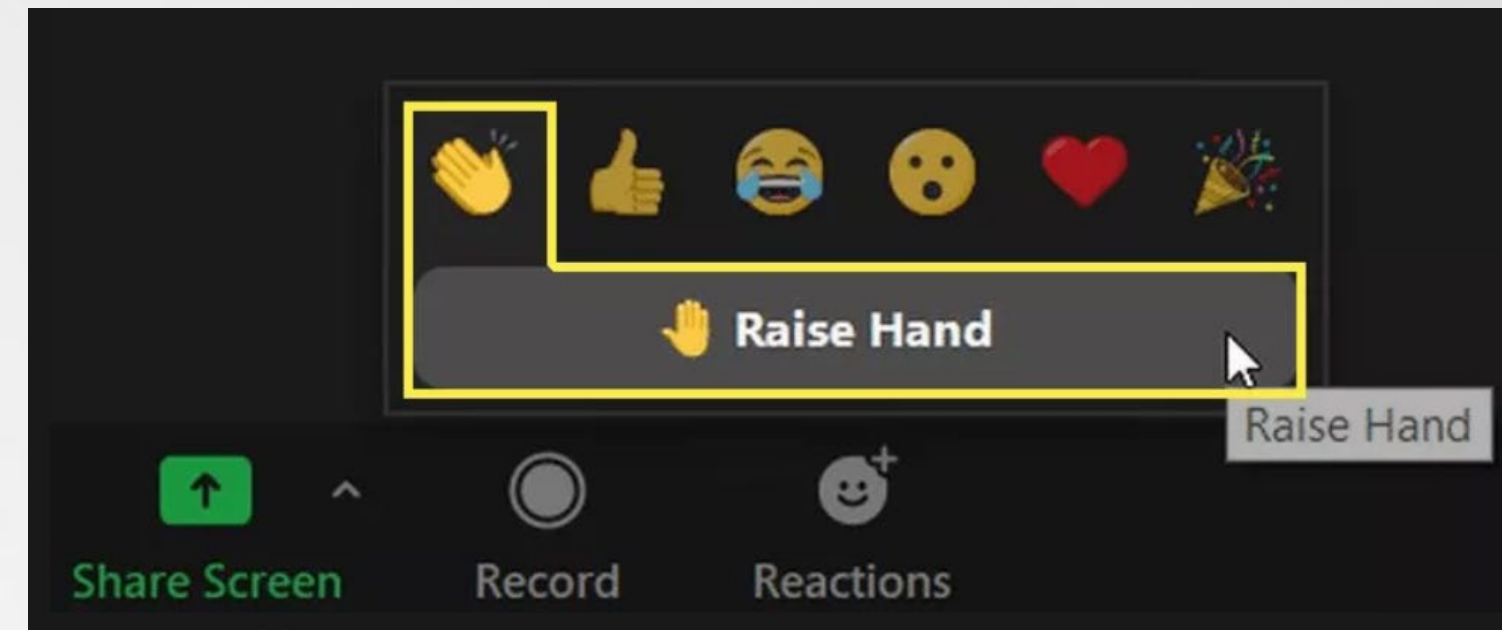

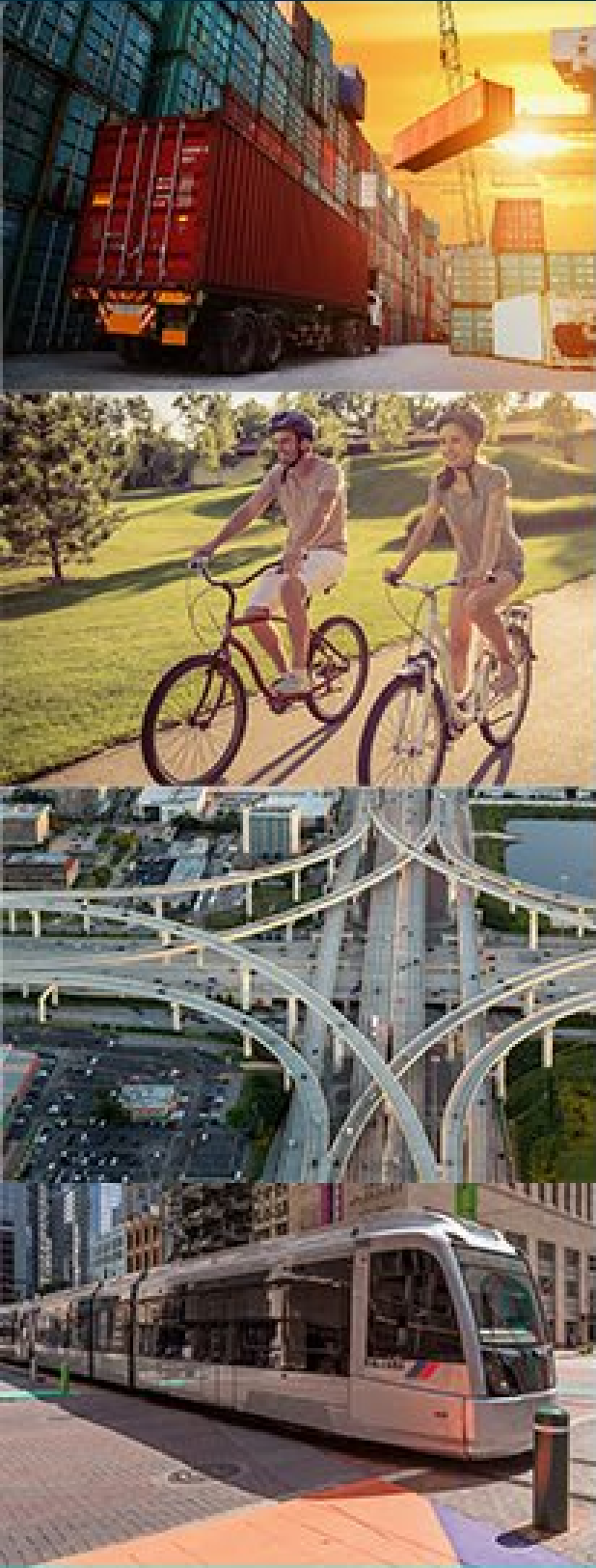

Metropolitan Planning Organization

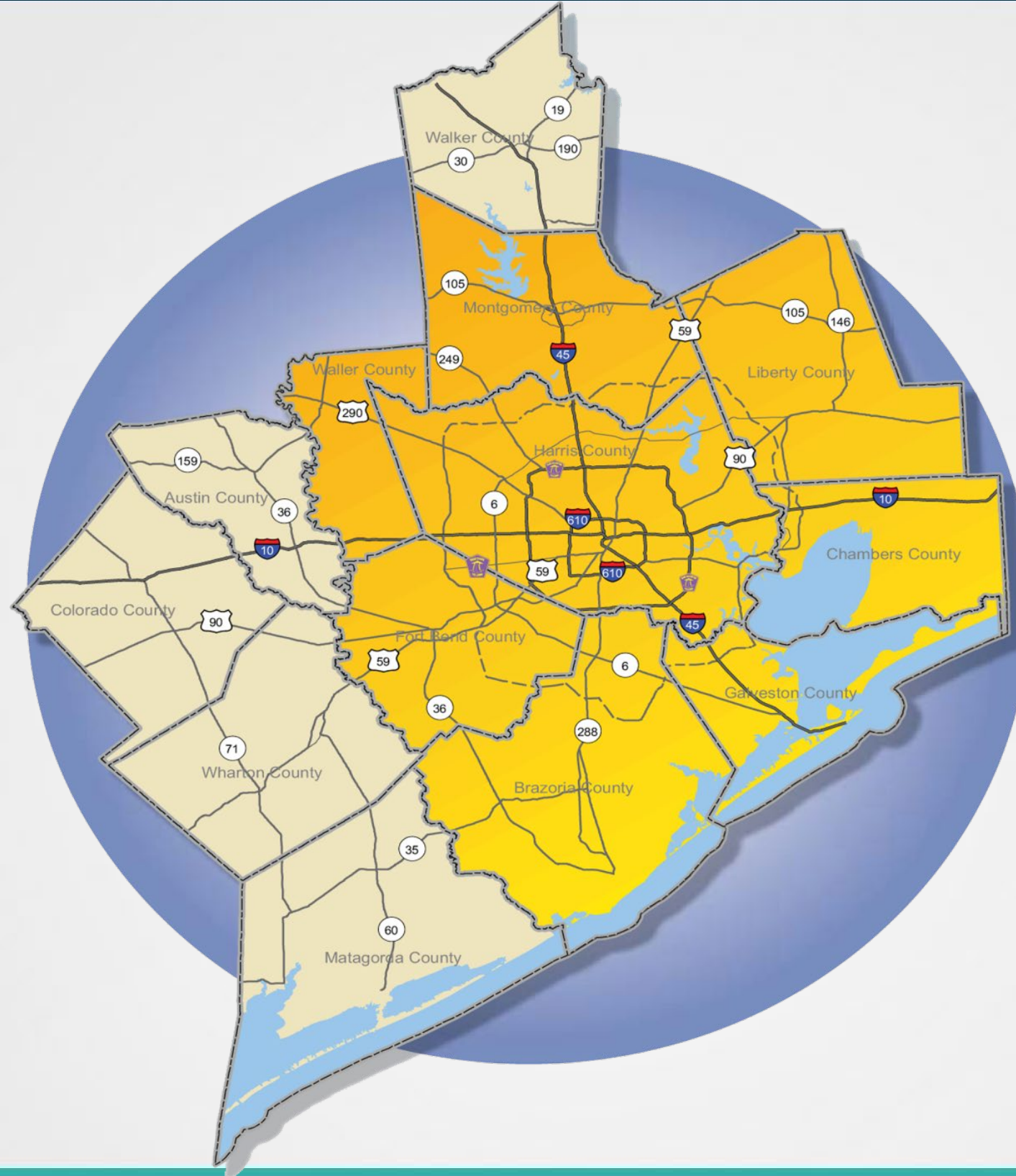


- Designated by Governor in 1974, includes:

Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

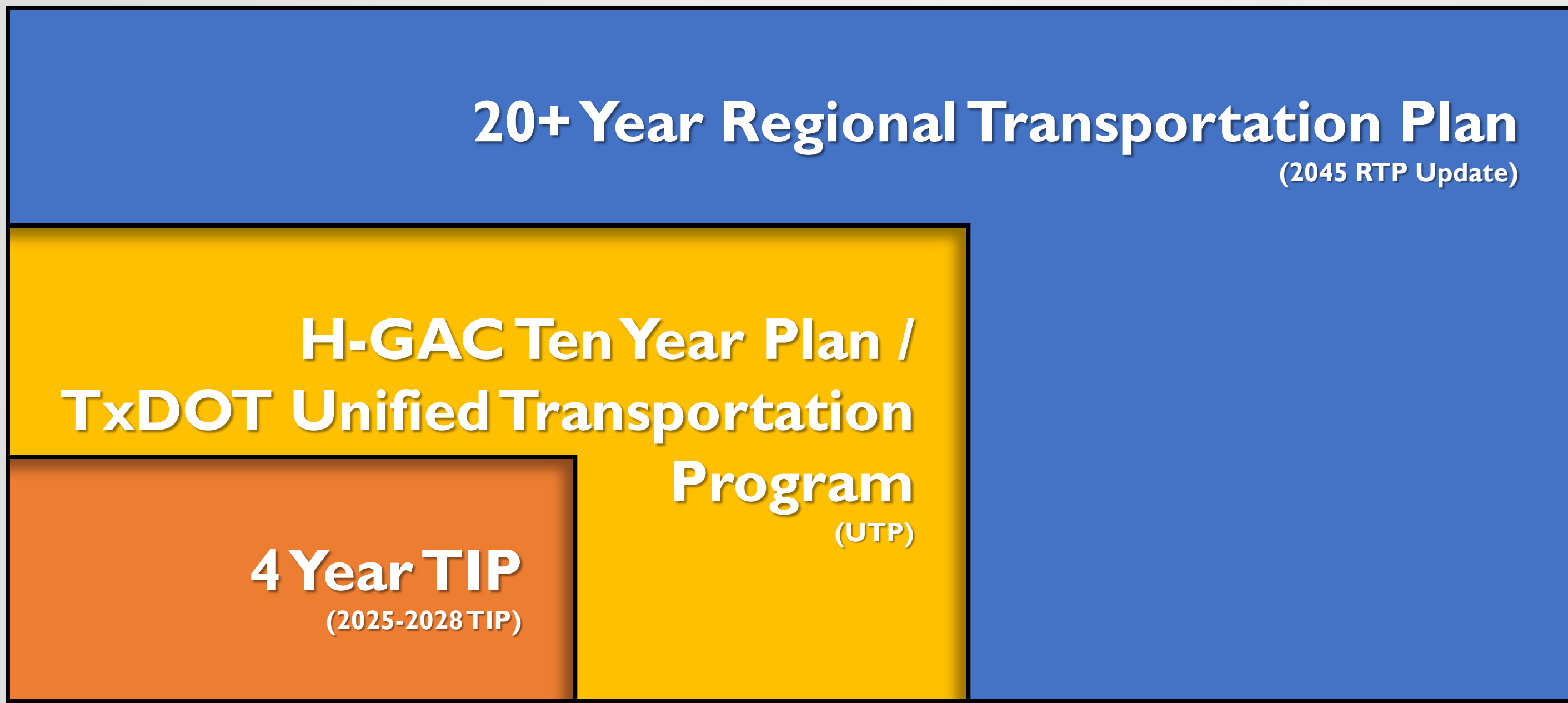


- 4-year program of transportation projects
 - Projects requiring federal action (\$\$, permits, etc.)
 - Other regionally significant projects
- Implementation device for long range plan (RTP)
- Financially constrained
- Multimodal
- Multijurisdictional

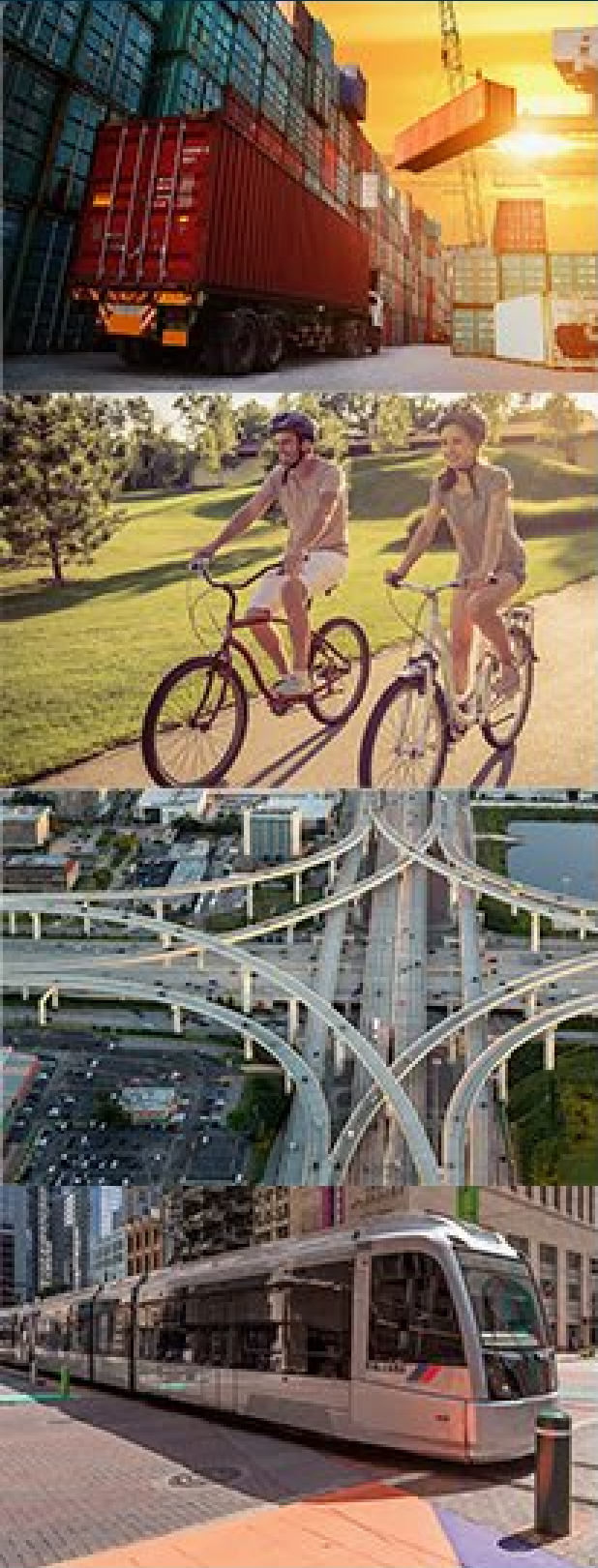
Purpose of the TIP

- Commitment (state and federal obligation) of expected funds
- Reflects regional priorities
- Public Comment and Notice required
- Gives locals the ability to say Yes or No (or Not now)
- Briefly describes projects, activities (scope of work), and costs
 - Preliminary engineering
 - Environmental
 - Final Design
 - Right-of-Way acquisition
 - Utility Adjustments
 - Construction

2025-2028 TIP Overview



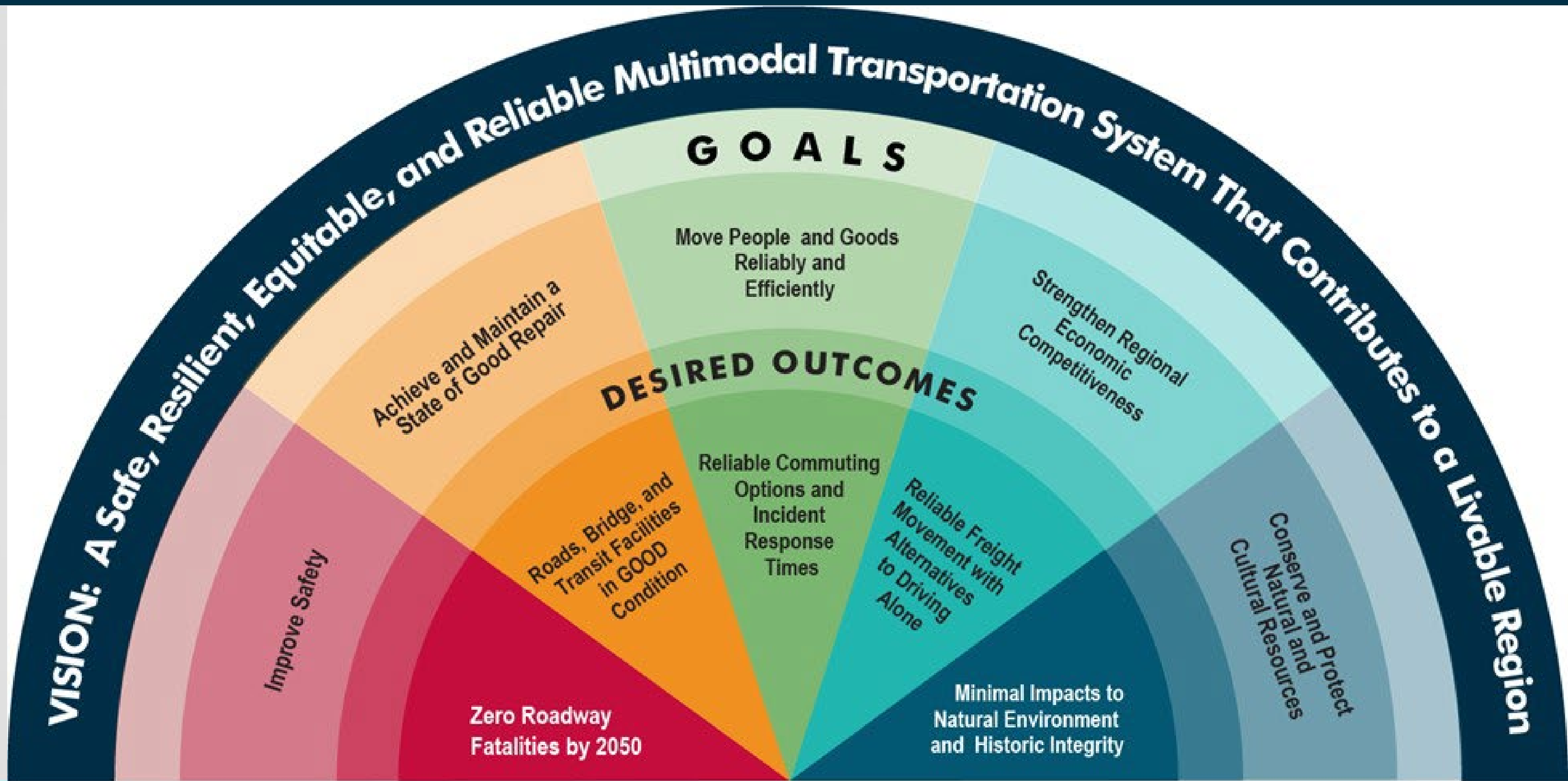

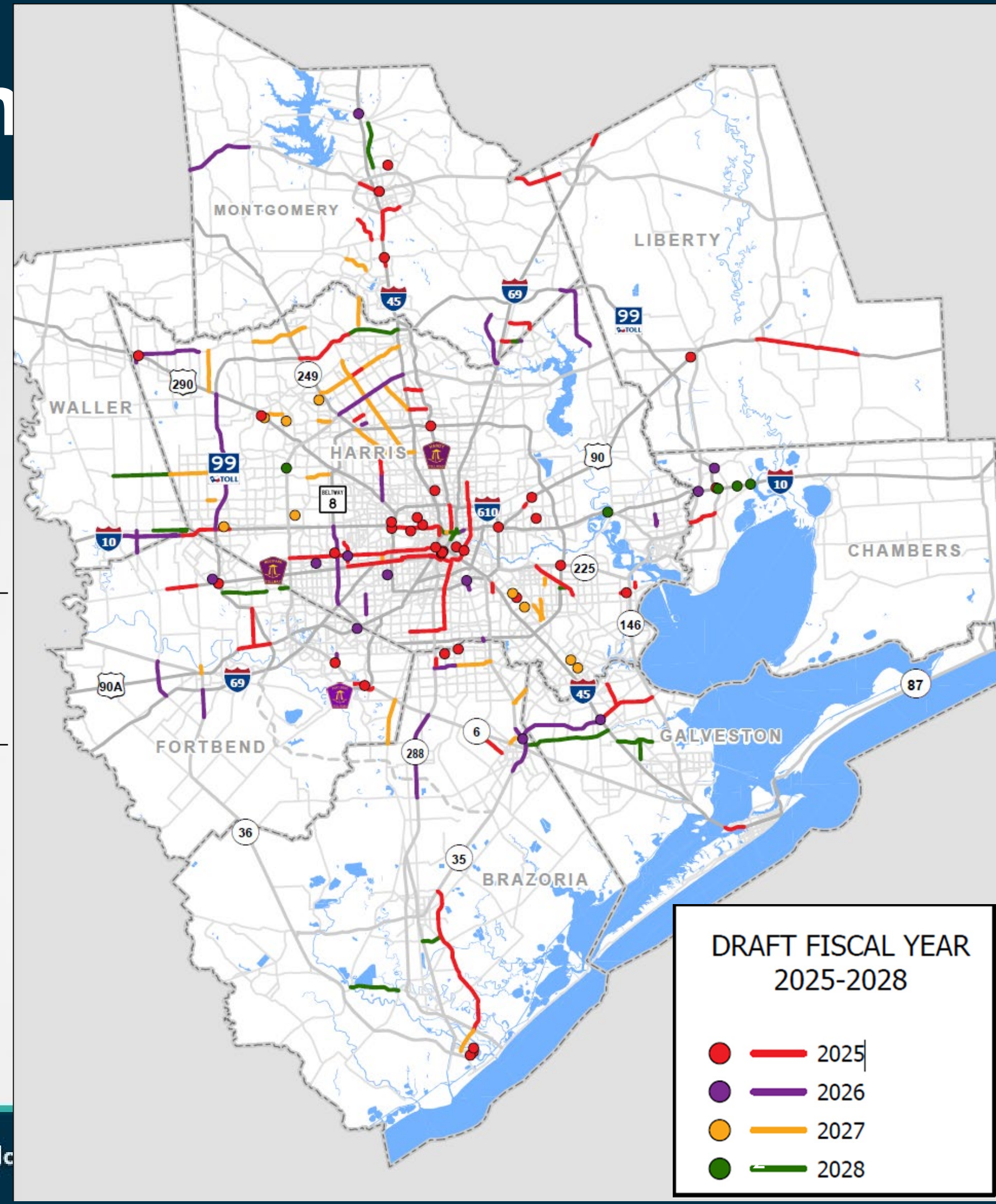

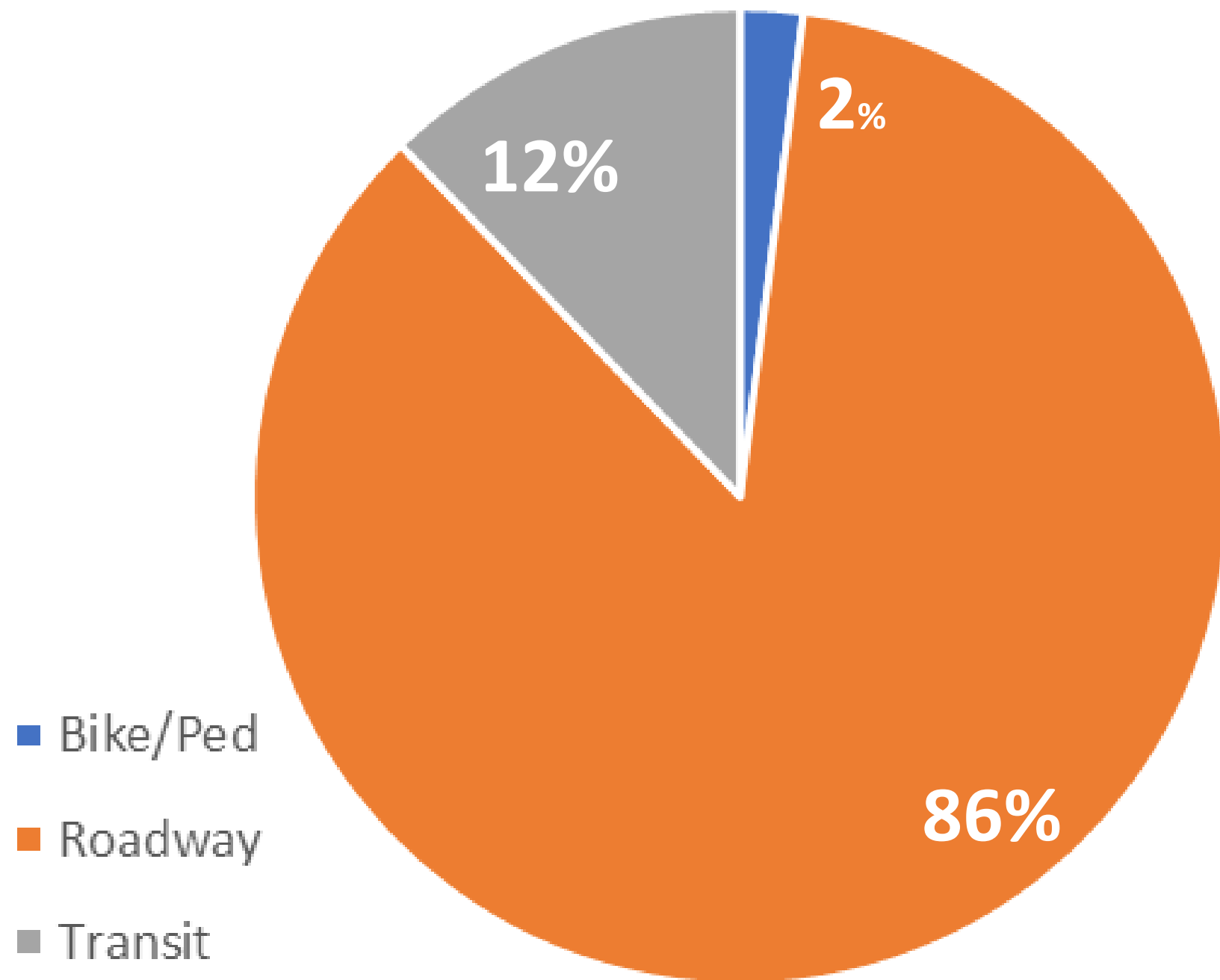


2025-2028 Major Projects

- North Houston Highway Improvement Program (NHHIP)
- Advanced ROW acquisition for NHHIP segment 1
- Reconstruct and widen IH-10 E San Jacinto River bridge.
- Reconstruct IH-10 W main lanes and existing HOV Lanes
- Construction of Grand Parkway (SH 99) segment B
- Construction of Direct Connectors on SH 610 S at SH 35
- Reconstruction and widen to add 4 managed lanes on IH 10 W
- Construction of Direct Connectors on SH 225 at SL 8
- Construction of Busway (BRT) from IH 610 W to Downtown Houston
- Construction of new BRT (University Line Corridor) from Westchase Park & Ride to Tidwell Transit Center

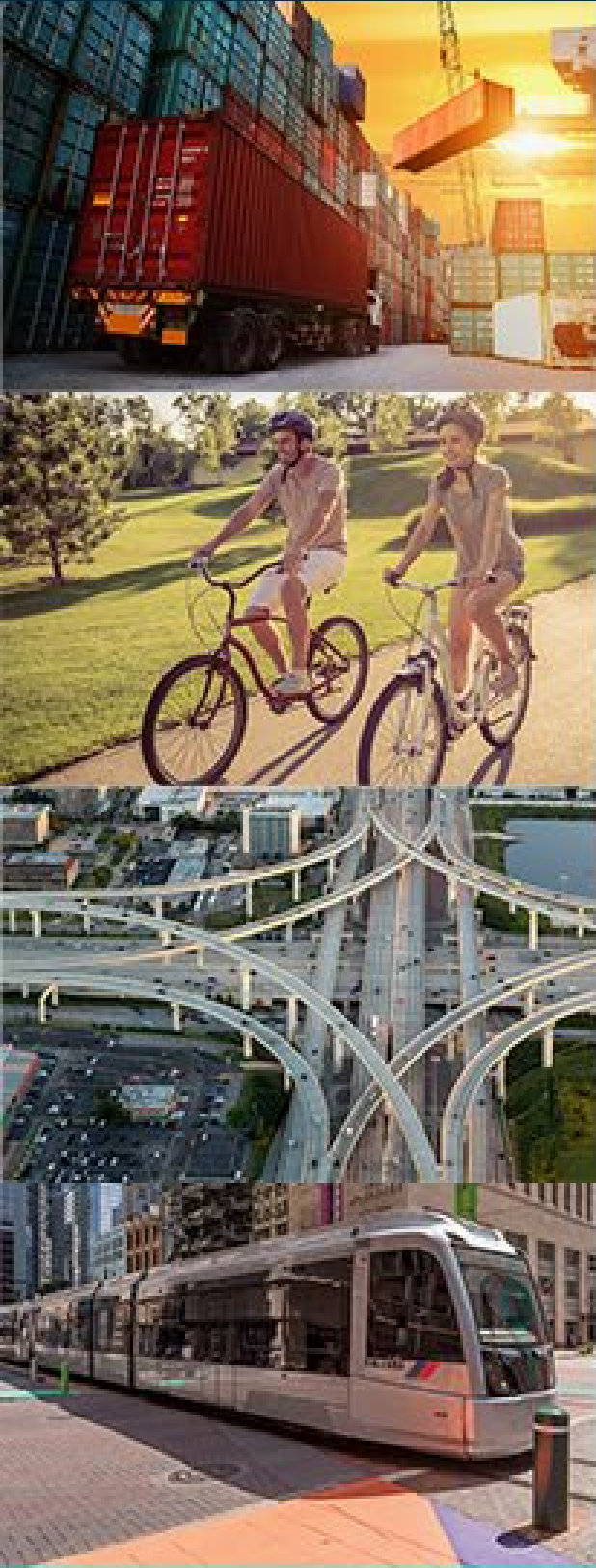
