I wanted to let you and your staff know that the Houston-Galveston Area Council will have 3 pedestrian counters installed on street signs and a canopy pole in the East End neighborhood area.

Locations of the counters are described below, and shown in the attached photographs:

- 1. Southwest corner of 18<sup>th</sup> Street and Market (on a canopy pole of the building addressed 1801 Market)
- 2. East side of 16<sup>th</sup> Street, between Market and Postoffice (on a utility pole adjacent to the Transitional Learning Center)
- 3. Adjacent to 1414 Strand (on an East End Historic District sign pole)

They have included a label on top of the counters with my contact information, in case someone sees it and has any questions. I wanted to bring it to your attention in case there are any calls to Police/Fire about devices strapped to poles. The three counters were installed today, March 4<sup>th</sup>, and will remain up for approximately one week.
