15. TITLE VI PROGRAM UPDATE

BACKGROUND

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in any program or activity conducted by recipients of Federal financial assistance. Discrimination includes the denial of meaningful access for persons with limited English language communication skills. To continue to be eligible for federal transit or highway funds, H-GAC must update its Title VI Program every three years and demonstrate that the agency complies with the U.S. Department of Transportation's Title VI regulations. H-GAC fully complies with Federal Title VI nondiscrimination requirements

CURRENT SITUATION

Work is underway to update the Title VI Program. Following Federal guidance, H-GAC's 2024 Triennial Title VI Program update includes:

- A nondiscrimination policy statement
- Certifications and Assurances of Title VI compliance
- Notice to the public of their rights under the Title VI statute
- A Public Participation Plan
- A description of Environmental Justice provisions
- A plan to accommodate persons with limited English communication skills
- An updated demographic profile of the metropolitan planning region
- Measures to assess regional equity in the impact of transportation
- Procedures for the submission and resolution of Title VI complaints, and
- Strategies for advancing Title VI and Environmental Justice
