

6. AMENDMENTS TO THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN

BACKGROUND

The 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is a four-year capital improvements program for transportation projects. Under federal rules, all federally assisted projects must be included in the TIP to be eligible for funding. In addition, federal rules require that regionally significant local projects must also be included in the TIP.

The 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) is a long-range plan that prioritizes spending on regional transportation projects including short and long-range strategies to ensure the transportation network is safe and efficient. Updated every four years, the RTP outlines a fiscally constrained transportation investment program that is based on the unique needs and characteristics of the MPO region. Amendments to the TIP and RTP are brought to the Transportation Policy Council for consideration monthly and amended in accordance with the H-GAC Public Participation Plan.

CURRENT SITUATION

A summary of the proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 TIP are included below for the Transportation Policy Council's consideration.

- Program Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County (METRO) vanpool projects funded with Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) in FY 2023 (MPO ID 18355/CSJ 0912-00-651) and FY 2024 (MPO ID 18356/CSJ 0912-00-653 & 18364/CSJ 0912-00-654) which were inadvertently left out of the 2023-2026 TIP. (+\$4.9M; Total Cost: \$4.9M)
- Program the Fort Bend County FM 521 widening project (MPO ID 17110/CSJ 0111-03-059) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) in FY 2023 as it was inadvertently left out of the 2023-2026 TIP. (+\$75.2M; Total Cost: \$75.2M)
- Program the Fort Bend County Public Transportation bus support project (MPO ID 18343/CSJ N/A) funded with FTA Section 5307 in FY 2024 as it was inadvertently left out of the 2023-2026 TIP. (+\$0.6M; Total Cost: \$0.6M)
- Delay the TXDOT Houston District SH 36 widening project (MPO ID 263/CSJ 0188-01-016) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) from FY 2023 to FY 2024 due to Right-of-Way and funding issues. (Total Cost: \$29.5M)
- Delay the TXDOT Houston District FM 2100 widening project (MPO ID 290/CSJ 0162-02-011) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) from FY 2024 to FY 2025 due to Right-of-Way and realignment issues. (Total Cost: \$31.0M)
- Delay the TXDOT Houston District SH 105 widening project (MPO ID 7706/CSJ 0338-07-019) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) from FY 2023 to FY 2025 due to a railroad agreement. (Total Cost: \$32.6M)
- Delay the Fort Bend County wireless traffic signal project (MPO ID 17062/CSJ 0912-34-192)

funded with CMAQ from FY 2023 to FY 2024 due to design changes. (Total Cost: \$6.7M)

- Delay the City of Tomball FM 2920 reconstruction project (MPO ID 17085/CSJ 2941-02-056) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) from FY 2023 to FY 2025 due to additional coordination required to confirm project scope. (Total Cost: \$28.6M)
- Delay the Montgomery County IH 45/SH 242 direct connector construction project (MPO ID 18028/CSJ 0110-04-205) funded locally from FY 2023 to FY 2024 due to design and agreement issues. (Total Cost: \$14.9M)
- Delay the TXDOT Houston District US 90A widening project in Fort Bend County (MPO ID 18029/CSJ 0027-08-147) funded with Metropolitan Mobility (Cat-2) from FY 2023 to FY 2024 due to two separate railroad agreements. (Total Cost: \$35.0M)
- Rescope the TXDOT Houston District IH 10 W widening project (MPO ID 6056/CSJ 0271-04-070) funded with Strategic Priority (Cat-12) replacing the frontage roads with managed lanes to match the adjoining sections on the corridor. (Total Cost: \$292.7M)
- Add \$5.4M of Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds to the Harris County MUD#500 Greenhouse Road at US 290 underpass construction project (MPO ID 18052/CSJ 0050-06-092) to cover costs of due inflation. Correct the federal/local funding split from 75%/25% to 80%/20%. (+\$5.4M; Total Cost: \$43.4M)
- Program the Gulf Coast Transit District’s FY 2022 Federal Transit Administration Section 5307, Urbanized Area Formula, Program of Projects (MPO IDs 18866, 18867, 18868, 18869, 18870 and 18871) in FY 2023 with 3.6M Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) in lieu of matching funds. Funding will provide for transit capital, planning and operating expenditures in the Texas City/La Marque and Lake Jackson/Angleton urbanized areas. (+\$4.0M)
- Modify the scope of the Fort Bend Public Transportation bus acquisition project (MPO ID 11935), funded with FTA Section 5339, Bus and Bus Facilities, funding to that of construction activities for the Westpark Tollway Park & Ride facility. The funding was obligated in FY 2020 of the 2019-2022 TIP. The 178K Transportation Development Credits will remain as the match.

AUTHORIZING AMENDMENTS OF THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP) AND THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA

WHEREAS, the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on April 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program for the Houston-Galveston Transportation Management Area was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on June 26, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan and its finding of conformance with the State Implementation Plan for air quality; and

WHEREAS, the proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the federal fiscal constraint requirements established for the Transportation Improvement Program and are consistent with the financially constrained 2045 Regional Transportation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA THAT THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND THE 2023–2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BE AMENDED TO REFLECT THE REVISIONS IDENTIFIED IN THE TABLE OF **AUGUST 2022 TPC AMENDMENTS**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT FEDERAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC FROM THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG) PROGRAMS REPRESENT A LIMITED AMOUNT. ANY COST OVERRUNS ON PHASES OF WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC OR COSTS INCURRED ON PHASES OF WORK NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROJECT SPONSOR. IN NO CASE, SHALL FEDERAL PARTICIPATION UNDER THE CMAQ AND STBG PROGRAMS BE INCREASED WITHOUT CONSULTATION AND THE EXPRESS APPROVAL OF THE TPC.

APPROVING THE AWARD OF TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS (TDCs) AND AUTHORIZING RELATED AMENDMENTS TO THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP), AND TO THE 2023-2026 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA.

WHEREAS, Texas Administrative Code, Title 43 Subchapter H, identifies the purpose, goals, and administrative requirements for the Transportation Development Credit Program in the State of Texas, including the sub-allocation of credits to Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs); and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation has documented the current balance of credits allocated to H-GAC, the MPO for the Houston-Galveston Transportation Management Area; and

WHEREAS, Texas Administrative Code, Title 43 §5.106, establishes requirements for the award of transportation development credits by MPOs; and

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council has established a documented process for the evaluation of applications and the award of credits; and

WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council is in receipt of requests for credits; and

WHEREAS, the award of credits for these purposes is consistent with the Policy governing the consideration of requests for credits adopted by the Policy Council on November 20, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA THAT TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT CREDITS BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PROJECTS IN THE ATTACHED TABLE #1 AND THAT THE TRANSPORTATION DIRECTOR IS DIRECTED TO ENTER INTO ANY NECESSARY PROJECT AGREEMENTS.

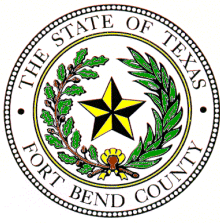

The above-referenced project was approved for funding by the TPC in the 2018 TIP for a 2024 Year of Expenditure. The original project was estimated at \$30,000,000 with a 25% local participation amount. With the customary escalation of 4% per year, the escalated project cost is \$37,959,571.

When the project reached the State level, it was approved as a CMAQ project as opposed to a STBG project on the STIP. Therefore, on behalf of the Sponsor, Harris County MUD 500 (MUD 500), they respectfully request that the funding category be changed from CMAQ funding to STBG funding as was originally intended.

Secondly, though the project was developed in accordance with all technical criteria, reviewing authorities mandated certain design preferences in the schematic design phase which resulted in a much larger project footprint, scope, and expense. Please refer to Attachment A – Cost Estimate Changes. As a consequence, the project costs have increased. Please refer to Attachment B – Preliminary Cost Estimate. Therefore, MUD 500 respectfully requests that the project funding award be increased to an overall budget of \$43,380,000 with a 20% local participation amount.

In summary, the project Sponsor requests:

1. Change the funding category from CMAQ to STBG; and
2. Increase the overall award amount to \$43,380,000 with a local participation of 20%.
