




### **April TIP and RTP Amendments**

- Split METRO FY 2025 IH 69 S Two-Way HOV Conversion (MPO ID 18188) in RTP.
   Program northern section from Westpark/Lower Uptown TC to SP 527 (MPO ID 19007) with \$184M local in FY 2026. (+\$184M; Total: \$184M)
- Increase HCTRA local funding \$92M to \$200M for SH 225 Direct Connectors at SL 8 (MPO ID 16340). Delay FY 2024 to FY 2025. (+\$108M; Total: \$200M)
- Update description of HCTRA SH 225 Direct Connectors at SL 8 (MPO ID 18883) to specify 4 DCs. Increase local funding. (+\$236M; Total: \$260M)
- Program TxDOT Houston District SH 225 main lane through interchange (MPO ID 18960) with State Cat-4 Statewide Connectivity funds in FY 2026. (+\$70.6M; Total: \$70.6M)










