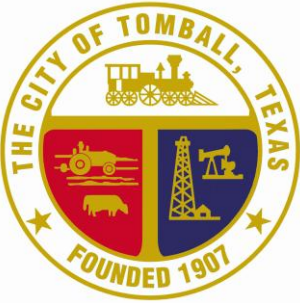
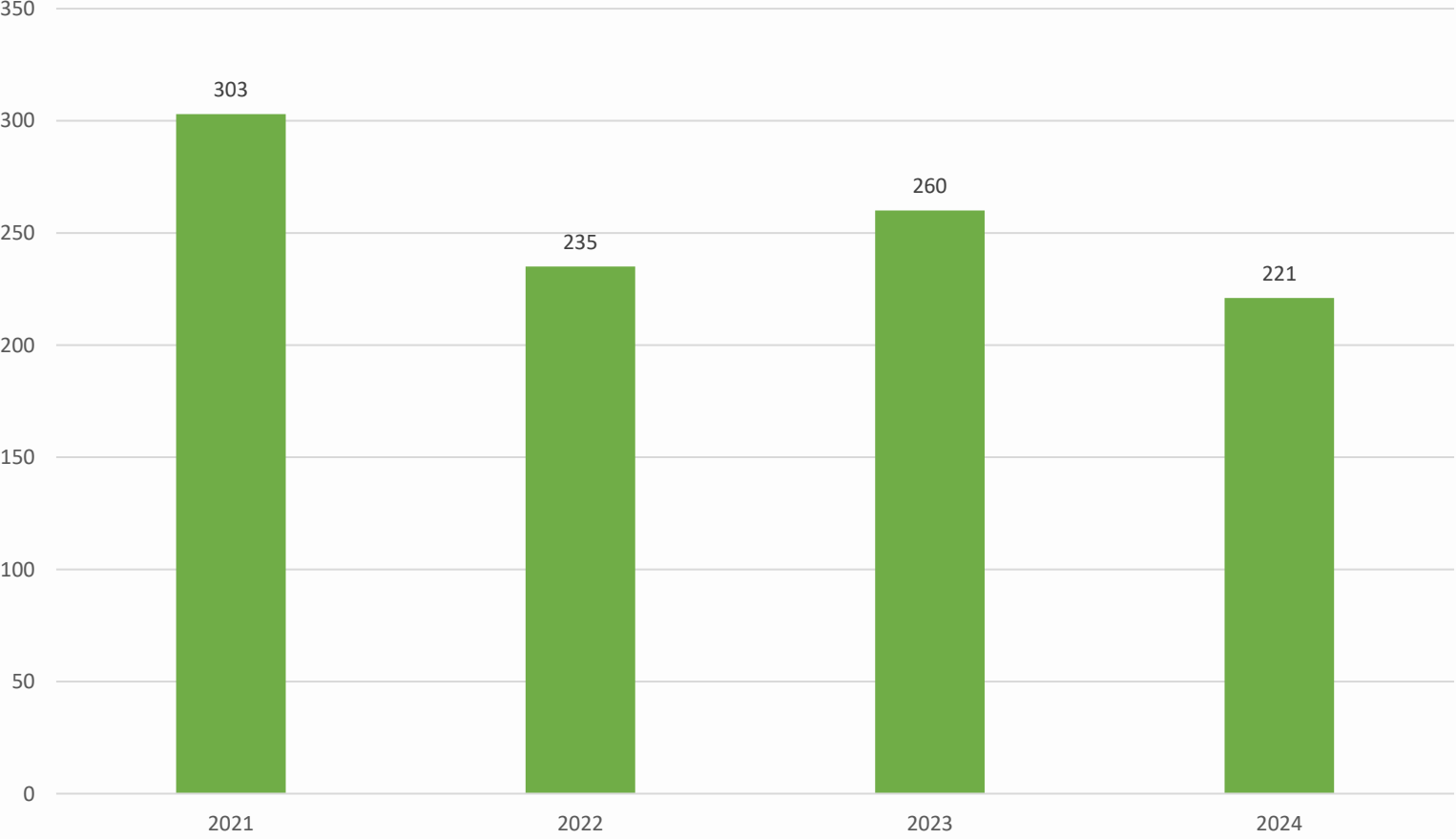


Recycling Services

Annual Program Participation

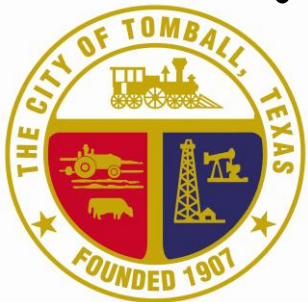
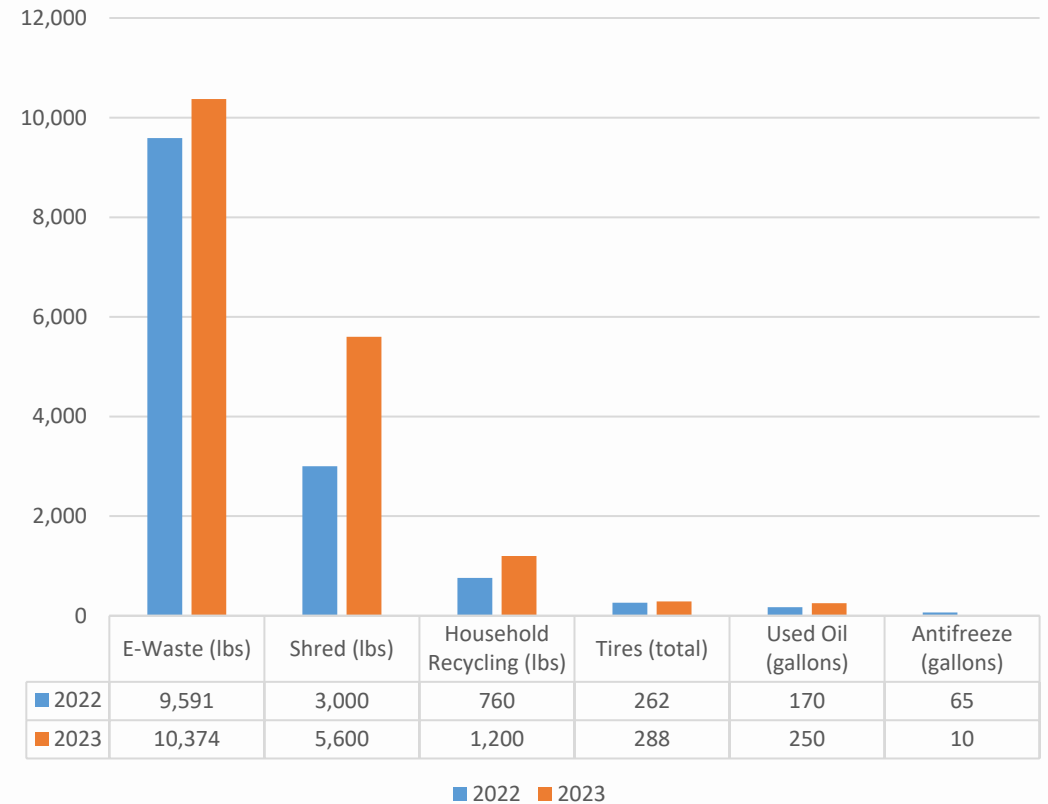

 - Drug Take Back: 170 gallons

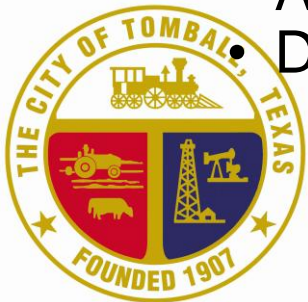
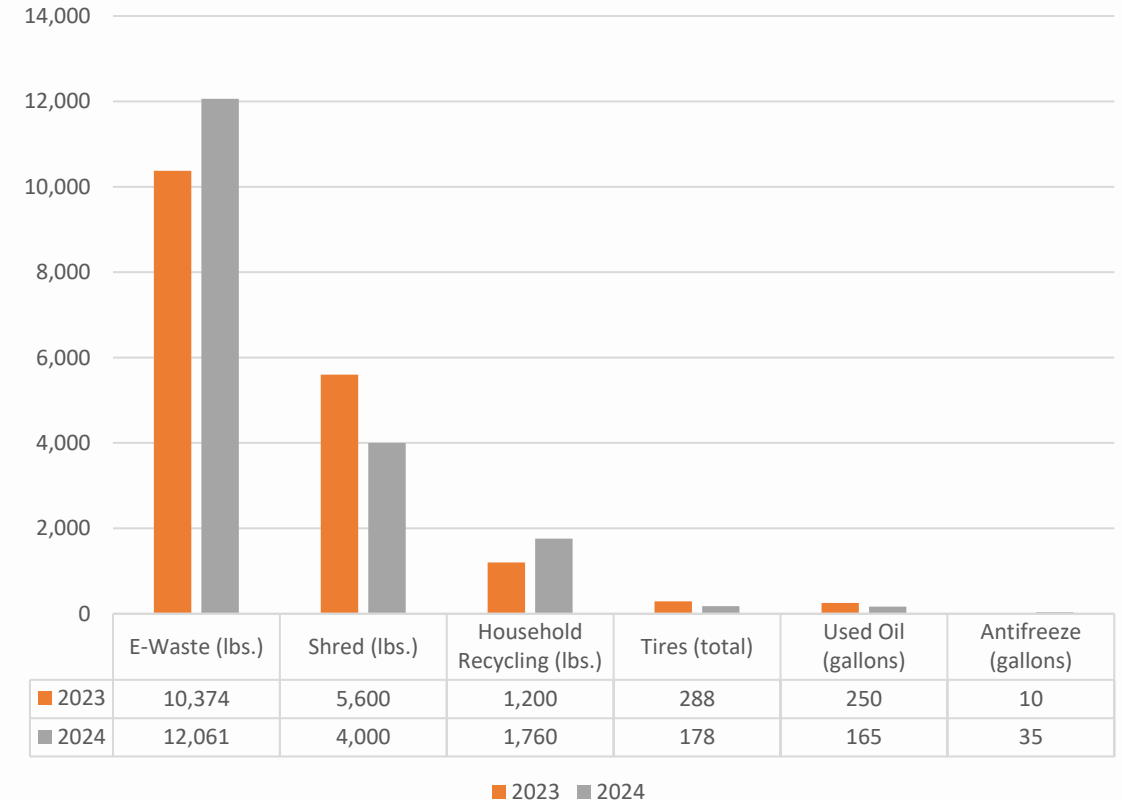
