## **Chambers County Quick Facts**

#### 51,288 Population (2022)

 Population grew by 31% in the last 5 years and is projected to grow by 7% in the next 5 years.

#### 22,088 Total County Employment (2023)

 Jobs grew by 43% in the last 5 years and are projected to grow by 23% in the next 5 years.

#### \$106K Median Household Income (2023)

 Median household income is \$31K above the national median household income of \$75K.
