ITEM 8. 2025-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AMENDMENTS, CALLIE BARNES, H-GAC AND JIM DICKINSON, H-GAC

A. Carryover Spend Down CMAQ TIP Amendments

Ms. Callie Barnes, H-GAC, gave the Council a presentation on CMAQ Carryover Spend Down Projects. Ms. Barnes provided details on projects submitted, methodology, current recommended CMAQ projects. Ms. Barnes informed the Council on a pause requested by TxDOT on CMAQ projects. TxDOT will review the projects and give comments by November 22nd. Staff expects to present them for action at the December TPC meeting. A comment period occurred after the presentation.

B. TIP Amendments

Mr. Jim Dickinson, H-GAC, presented A summary of the proposed revision to the Texas Department of Transportation Statewide Bicycle and Pedestrian Program is included below.

Program an additional \$993K of federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) funds, matched with local funds by the City of Bellaire, to cover the increased cost estimates that are due to inflation. The project scope will also be modified to use the most appropriate technology.

A summary of the proposed revision to the 2025-2028 Transportation Improvement Program is included below.

 Program 3.7M Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) in lieu of matching funds for the Uptown Management District's Transportation Alternative Set-Aside (TASA) funded West Loop Shared-Use Path construction project.

Mr. Dickinson requested approval of TPC Resolution No. 2024-42 and TPC Resolution No. 2024-43. A discussion period occurred after the presentation. A motion was made by Mayor Joe Zimmerman and seconded by Mayor Kevin Cole. The Council voted and approved TPC Resolution No. 2024-42 and TPC Resolution No. 2024-43. ITEM 9. PROPOSED STRATEGIC HIGHWAY NETWORK (STRAHNET) DESIGNATION LOCATIONS, ALLIE ISBEL, H-GAC

Ms. Allie Isbell, H-GAC, provided a presentation on the Proposed Strategic Highway Network Designation locations. The STRAHNET is a 62,792- mile system of roads deemed necessary for emergency mobilization and peacetime movement of heavy armor, fuel, ammunition, repair parts, food, and other commodities to support U.S. military operations. 14 routes were added in Texas, 1 within the H-GAC region. Ms. Isbell requested TPC concurrence to enable submission to the Federal Highway Administration. Ms. Isbell requested approval of TPC Resolution No. 2024-36. A motion was made by Mayor Zimmerman and seconded by Mayor Kevin Cole. The Council voted and approved TPC Resolution No. 2024-36. ITEM 10. REGIONAL GOODS MOVEMENT WORKSHOP UPDATE, SYDNI LIGONS, H-GAC

Ms. Sydni Ligons, H-GAC, provided an update to the Council on the Regional Goods Movement Workshop. The Regional Goods Movement Plan is a long-range plan for a system of movement of goods in the Houston-Galveston Region. The plan is designed to ensure the region can continue playing a critical role in national and international supply chains while meeting many goals in the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan. Ms. Ligons proceeded to inform the Council that H-GAC hosted a RGM Plan Lessons Learned Workshop in September where the plan was reviewed, recommendations were made and next steps discussed.
