

# H-GAC's Solid Waste Program for FY22/23

# Funding

## Overall

- \$1,006,664 per year
  - This is \$1,375 more per year than the current biennium
- Total for the biennium is \$2,013,328

## Grant Program

- \$550,000 per year or \$1.1 million for the biennium
- This is the same as the current biennium

# Grant Program

- One round of applications
- Grantees split evenly between the two years
  - Grants will start in either March 2022 or September 2022
- No minimum or maximum grant amount

- Education and Training
- Household Hazardous Waste Management
- Litter and Illegal Dumping Cleanup and Community Collection Events
- Local Enforcement

- Technical Studies
- Other
