- Rider 7 Air Quality Planning Grant for near non-attainment areas
- Texas Commission on Environmental Quality's Legislative Appropriation from 88th Legislature
- H-GAC was awarded \$450,000
- Funded activities are limited to:
  - Inventorying emissions
  - Monitoring of pollution levels
  - Air Pollution and data analysis
  - Modeling pollution levels
  - Project administration



# **Speciation Study**



- Analyze the components of PM2.5 in our region to better understand the impact on human health
- Built on previous studies, such as the TCEQ North Wayside report, for further analysis of PM2.5 composition and sources
- Focusing on near-road locations, industrial areas, sites in Environmental Justice Areas, or locations with heavy truck traffic.


