

#### **Benefit-Cost Scoring**

- 34 of 40 Projects were scored for BCA
- Total Benefits/Total Cost
- B/C ratios ranged from 0.0 to 101.9
- Converted benefit/cost ratios > 1.0 to points (0 -100)
  - 24 projects
  - 4 approaches considered
- Ranking list presented is based on approach 4
  - B/C ratios: > 5.0 = 100, 4.0 3.0 = 75, 2.0 3.0 = 50, 1.0 2.0 = 25
  - Sorted high-low total score (including Evaluation score + BCA score)



## RGM Projects Draft Ranking

- Draft Ranking list included in the Packet
- Programming years based on readiness information
  - Engineering and construction phases
- Calculates total cost based on budgets provided and programming years
  - Engineering and construction phases
- Cumulative total for total project cost
