

**AMENDMENTS TO THE 2021-24 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM  
(TIP) AND 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP)**

**Background**

Amendments to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan will be presented and discussed in two parts. Item 10-A contains amendments to the TIP and RTP that have been submitted to H-GAC in November and December 2020. Item 10-B contains amendments to the TIP and RTP that are a result of the statewide fiscal constraint exercise being led by the Texas Department of Transportation in Austin.

**Summary**

**10-A TPC Amendments to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan.**

- Program the Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County's (Metro) Regional Transit Fare Collection System Implementation project in FY 2021 of the TIP with Federal Transit Administration Section 5339 Bus and Bus Facilities Formula Program funding.
- Program the City of Galveston's (Island Transit) FY 2020 Coordinated Call for Projects Fleet Replacement Program award in FY 2021 of the TIP. The Texas Department of Transportation's Public Transportation Division flexed Surface Transportation Block Grant Program funding into the Federal Transit Administration Section 5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program. The program requested projects to replace fleet vehicles or assist in keeping current capital in a state of good repair for Urban Transit Districts.
- Program 20,000 Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) in lieu of matching funds on the Houston-Galveston Area Council's Multimodal Network Connectivity Pilot Studies project. The Federal Highway Administration awarded \$100,000 from the Highway Research and Development Program.
- Program \$200,000 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act allocation of FTA Section 5307 funding from the Texas Department of Transportation's Governor's Apportionment for construction expenditures on the Lake Jackson Transit Maintenance Facility.

**10-B – TPC amendments to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan as a result of 2021-2024 Statewide Transportation improvement Program (STIP) fiscal constraint exercise.**

Since July the TxDOT's Transportation Planning and Programming division (TPP) worked with Houston and Beaumont Districts staff to move some projects between fiscal years within the STIP time frame and some out of the STIP timeframe to fiscally constrain the 2021 STIP. To reflect these changes to the 2021 TIP projects TxDOT Houston District is requesting the following changes to the 2021 TIP.

- Administratively amend the projects listed in Attachment - A – Information Only to move between fiscal years within the 2021 TIP. Removal of projects listed in
- Attachment – B – Information Only. Project LET since the adoption of 2021 TIP. Summary of funding by category is provided in Table 1.

On November 15, 2019, a Coordinated Call for Projects was published which included a Fleet Replacement Program. The program requested projects to replace fleet or assist in keeping current capital in a state of good repair for Urban Transit Districts. Attached is a list showing the funding allocations and Transportation Development Credits (TDC) available as match for the ten agencies with successful urbanized area applications.


Funds for this program in the amount of \$4,376,115 were flexed from the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program to the 49 U.S.C. §5307 Urbanized Area Formula Program. TxDOT authorizes the assignment/allocation of Section §5307 to the Direct Recipient(s) recognized for each urbanized area. Each Direct Recipient is responsible for its application to the Federal Transit Administration to receive Section 5307 funds and assumes the responsibilities associated with any award for these funds.

The Public Transportation Program managed by the Public Transportation Division (PTN) of Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) was allocated 15,000,000 Transportation Development Credits (TDC) for distribution to eligible projects by the Texas Transportation Commission in Minute Order 115550 for state fiscal year 2020.

TDC awards are available as match in amounts shown in the attachment based on the submitted fleet replacement applications. Once FTA has approved the related grant application, the agency must notify PTN of the FAIN number and PTN will issue a TDC agreement.

**WHEREAS**, the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on April 5, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program for the Houston-Galveston Transportation Management Area was adopted by the Transportation Policy Council on June 26, 2020; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed revisions to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan and its finding of conformance with the State Implementation Plan for air quality; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed revisions to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program are consistent with the federal fiscal constraint requirements established for the Transportation Improvement Program and are consistent with the financially constrained 2045 Regional Transportation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRANSPORTATION POLICY COUNCIL (TPC) FOR THE HOUSTON-GALVESTON TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT AREA THAT THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN AND THE 2021-2024 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM BE AMENDED TO REFLECT THE REVISIONS IDENTIFIED IN THE TABLE OF **JANUARY 2021 TPC AMENDMENTS**.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT FEDERAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC FROM THE CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY (CMAQ) AND SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT (STBG) PROGRAMS REPRESENT A LIMITING AMOUNT. ANY COST OVERRUNS ON PHASES OF WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC OR COSTS INCURRED ON PHASES OF WORK NOT AUTHORIZED BY THE TPC SHALL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROJECT SPONSOR. WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council has established a documented process for the evaluation of applications and the award of credits; and


WHEREAS, the Houston-Galveston Area Council is in receipt of requests for credits; and

WHEREAS, the award of credits for these purposes is consistent with the Policy governing the consideration of requests for credits adopted by the Policy Council on November 20, 2020.


