I. OVERVIEW

Per Umbrella Contract 582-12-13254, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) requested Public Outreach support from the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) for Jarbo Bayou Bacteria TMDL project, with activities for all elements of Public Outreach including, but not necessarily limited to:

- Identifying and Reserving Facilities for Meetings and / or Events:
- Providing a Facilitator for Any Meetings (As Needed);
- Providing Support for Organizing and Advertising Meetings and / or Events;
- Distribution and Posting of Meeting Agenda(s);
- Preparation of Meeting and / or Event Summaries;
- Preparation of Printed or Other Presentation Materials in Support of a Meeting and / or Event;
- Use of the H-GAC Website for Posting Meeting and / or Event Information; and
- Any Other Necessary Support Activities.

On December 12, 2013 (Round 1), H-GAC conducted a single public meeting in Clear Lake Shores. On January 23, 2014 (Round 2), H-GAC conducted a second public meeting in fulfillment of its contractual obligation. On February 27, 2014 (Round 3), the kick-off meeting for the Coordination Committee was held.

II. LOCATION / GEOGRAPHY

According to the Texas State Historical Association, Jarbo Bayou, a part of the San Jacinto - Brazos basin, rises two miles northeast of League City in northern Galveston County and flows northeast for two miles to its mouth on Clear Lake, just east of Clear Lake Shores and west of Kemah.



III. PURPOSE

Since 2002, high concentrations of bacteria, which are found in both human and animal waste, have been observed in the bayou.

The presence of these bacteria may indicate a health risk to people who swim or wade in the bayou-activities referred to as "contact recreation" in the Texas Surface Water Quality Standards.

The purpose of the second Coordination Committee meeting on April 10, 2014 was threefold:

- 1. Provide an update on the TMDL status (University of Houston presentiaton)
- 2. Provide answers to frequently asked questions to help better prime the group for discussions moving forward
- 3. Distribute a copy of current Coordination Committee List
- 4. Discuss general pros / cons for joining the BIG

IV. APPROACH

For Round 4 of this effort, a single meeting was conducted in the City of Clear Lake Shores to the existing stakeholder database / nominated Coordination Committee members.

V. NOTIFICATION

Existing stakeholder database / nominated Coordination Committee members were contacted via phone to determine preferred dates / times for the kickoff meeting, and received subsequent email invitations and reminders notifying them of meeting details.

- 1. What is an MS4 permit?
 - a. Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4)
- 2. Has boater waste been identified as a potential bacteria source? Does it have a relationship to tidal flow (Clear Creek monitoring station 16671)?
 - Station 16671 is being regularly monitored.
 - It is assumed that boater waste is one of several bacteria contributors for the project area.
- 2. None of the sample sites indicate point sources?
 - Without WWTF outfall within the project area, this cannot be measures.
 - Perhaps adjacent outfalls could be measured in the future as an additional data point.
- 3. Would the Coordination Committee for Jarbo Bayou still exist, even if it joins the BIG?
 - o Yes.
