Mayor Joe Zimmerman made a motion to approve the modifications to the membership of the Transportation Safety Committee and a second motion was made by Council Member David Robinson. The Council voted and the motion carried.

ITEM 7. APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION FOR THE NORTH HOUSTON HIGHWAY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (OLD BUSINESS), CRAIG RABORN, H-GAC

Mr. Craig Raborn presented on this item for approval of a Resolution relating to the North Houston Highway Improvement Project (NHHIP). At the TPC meeting on January 22, 2021, Resolution No. 2021-01 was tabled for further discussion. Following that meeting staff coordinated discussions with leadership of the TPC and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) Working Group. Based on those discussions, Substitute Resolution 2021-11 was prepared and presented as a potential_substitute for tabled Resolution No. 2021-01.

Mr. Raborn presented three options for TPC's consideration, approval of the substitute Resolution 2021-11, take no action, or approval of Resolution No. 2021-01 that was presented at TPC in January.

Numerous public comments had been provided on this item, and the Council discussed options for updating the language of Substitute Resolution 2021-11 based on the public's comments, retaining the language of tabled Resolution 2021-01, or adopting Substitute Resolution 2021-11 as provided.

Commissioner Justin Beckendorff moved to take Resolution 2021-01 from the table and substitute it with Resolution 2021-11. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Billy Combs.

The motion to take Resolution 2021-01 from the table passed on a voice vote. The following seven members objected: Carol Haddock, Council Member David Robinson, Council Member Sallie Alcorn, John Blount, Milton Rahman, Carrin Patman and Roger Guenther.

After additional discussion of the motion to substitute the language of Resolution 2021-01 with the Resolution 2021-11, Judge Keough moved that the question be called. The motion passed, with Carol Haddock opposing.

Carrin Patman moved to indefinitely postpone consideration of the motion to substitute Resolution 2021-11 for Resolution 2021-01. Dr. Lewis seconded the motion. A roll call vote was conducted, and the motion to postpone Resolution 2021-11 was not approved with 11 voting for and 14 voting against the motion.

A roll call vote was then conducted on the motion to approve Resolution 2021-11. Resolution 2021-11 was approved by the Transportation Policy Council with 15 voting for and 10 voting against the motion.

ITEM 8. AMENDMENTS TO THE 2021-2021 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP) AND THE 2045 REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN (RTP), VISHU LINGALA. H-GAC

Mr. Vishu Lingala presented on the Amendments to the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and the 2045 Regional Transportation Plan (RTP) and is seeking TPC approval of Resolution 2021-09 and Resolution 2021-10. The amendments are as follows:

- Program 4,712,000 Transportation Development Credits (TDCs) in lieu of matching funds on fourteen (14) Metropolitan Transit Authority of Harris County (METRO) and Houston-Galveston Area Council projects funded with federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ). These federal funds for these projects were originally programmed during the development of the 2021-2024 Transportation Improvement Program.
- Delay three (3) projects from the TIP into FY 2025 of the Houston-Galveston Area Council's Ten-Year Transportation Plan (10Y) at the Texas Department of Transportation's request to fiscally constrain the 2021 Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).
- Move the FY 2021 Metro Regional Vanpool project, funded with federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds, from the TIP into the Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Statewide Program for transit improvements (under a statewide Control-Section-Job number) at the TxDOT's request to fiscally constrain the 2021 STIP.

A motion was made by Ms. Patman and a second motions was made by Mr. Beckendorff. The Council voted and the motion carried.

ITEM 9. AMENDMENTS TO THE 2021-2022 UNIFIED PLANNING WORK PROGRAM (UPWP), NEELY KIM, H-GAC

Ms. Neely Kim presented on the amendments to the 2021-2022 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) and is seeking TPC approval. H-GAC received Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds through two Advance Funding Agreements including a total amount of \$5M for the various planning projects listed below:

- 1. Safety Intersection Audits
- 2. Regional Goods Movement Plan Update
- 3. Montgomery County Precinct 2 Mobility Study
- 4. Liberty County Transportation Plan
- 5. Southeast Harris County Sub-regional Study

Currently, these projects are included in the 2020-2021 UPWP, but STBG funds are not noted in the budget. The following items show a summary of proposed modifications by task and subtask to add STBG funds:

- 1. Task 3-Subtask 3.4a of the 2020-2021 UPWP includes a planning activity to conduct safety intersection studies at pilot intersection locations that have high crash density. An additional \$1M in STBG funds are proposed to be added to Task 3-Subtask 3.4a under FY 2021 of the UPWP to fund Safety Intersection Audits.
- Task 4-Subtask 4.3b of the 2020-2021 UPWP includes a freight planning activity to update the Regional Goods Movement Plan. An additional \$1M in STBG funds are proposed to be added to Task 4-Subtask 4.3b under FY 2021 of the UPWP to update the Regional Goods Movement Plan.
- 3. Task 4-Subtask 4.3c of the 2020-2021 UPWP includes three sub-regional studies: Montgomery County Precinct 2 Mobility Study, Liberty County Transportation Plan, and Southeast Harris County Sub-regional Study. An additional \$2.1M in STBG funds are proposed to be added to Task 4- subtask 4.3c under FY 2021 of the UPWP to provide support to the above planning projects.

A motion was made by Mayor Joe. Zimmerman and a second motions was made by Mr. David Collins. The Council voted and the motion carried.
